- *6 County Commissioners or Council Members
- *3 County Engineers
- *Quarterly Meetings

County Road Administration Board

Establish and Administering:

- Standards of Good Practice (RCW 36.78)
- Certificate of Good Practice – Annually
- Grant Programs – RAPP-1983 , CAPP-1990
- RAPP – 0.58 Cents - CAPP – 0.45 Cents
- County Roadlog and MVFT Calculation
- Capital Ferry Program

County Road Administration Board

Three Functional Areas:

- Executive Services – Legislature, WSAC, WSACE...
- Engineering Services - RAPP, CAPP, Roadlog, MVFT, PMS and Pavement Rating
- Information Services – Software, Training, Support

WAC 136 – 60

Maintenance of the County Road Logs

Calendar Year Updates to CRAB by May 1st of the Following Year.

Control Field Changes: Need to Include **Signed Documentation for the Following Changes:**

Addition or Deletion of: BMP, EMP, or Changes to Jurisdiction, Length, FFC, Surface Type or Width, Shoulder Type or Width, Average Daily Traffic Volume – (Plus or Minus 5000 ADT).

WAC 136 – 60

Validation of Annual Update

- All Control Fields Subject to Review and Acceptance
- Conducting Field Spot Checks as may be Necessary
- Non-Control Field Updates Entered without Review
- Master County Road Log Completed by July 1st

Pavement Management System will be used to “Guide”
Counties Preservation Activities

All County Paved Arterials shall be Surveyed for Visual
Pavement Distress at Least Biennially (Every 2 Years)

Pavement Distress Data may be Collected either by
Visual or Automated Rating Process
